Re: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT

Dear Mayor Bowser:

This letter is to inform you that on February 2, 2015, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Tracie Harper-Forte, a former District of Columbia employee, to 180 days of incarceration suspended and 5 years of probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Health (DOH). In addition, the court ordered Ms. Harper-Forte to pay restitution in the amount of \$17,912.

The D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) investigation revealed that from February 14, 2009, through May 9, 2009, Ms. Harper-Forte engaged in a scheme to defraud DOH of \$17,912 by claiming and receiving pay for 126 hours of overtime that was not authorized. On February 2, 2015, Ms. Harper-Forte pled guilty to one count of Misdemeanor Fraud in the First Degree.
