Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on September 12, 2014, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Denise Riccardo, a member of the public, to 6 months incarceration (suspended), 1 year supervised release (suspended), and 5 years supervised probation for fraudulently obtaining unemployment insurance (UI) benefits from the D.C. Department of Employment Services (DOES). In addition, the Court ordered Ms. Riccardo to pay restitution in the amount of \$24,628.

Special Agent Emmit Garner of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from April 24, 2010, through July 30, 2011, Ms. Riccardo filed false weekly claims with DOES and received UI benefits while concurrently working and earning wages. On July 1, 2014, Ms. Riccardo pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree.
