Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on May 16, 2013, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced George Bullock, a former Workers Compensation Investigator with the Department of Employment Services (DOES), to 60 days of incarceration (two 30-day sentences to run concurrently) (suspended), and 6 months of probation (two 6-month terms to run concurrently), for falsifying two employment applications with the District of Columbia government.

Special Agent Raymond Malengo of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from November 2005 through September 2012, Mr. Bullock submitted numerous employment applications for positions within the District government that listed a bachelor's degree issued by a known diploma mill. After the investigation, on May 16, 2013, Mr. Bullock pled guilty to two counts of False Statements.
