Dear Mayor Bowser:

This letter is to inform you that on August 4, 2015, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Cherita Whiting, former Special Assistant, Department of Parks and Recreation, to 60 days of incarceration (suspended), and 5 years of supervised probation for defrauding the Department of Employment Services (DOES). In addition, the court ordered Ms. Whiting to pay restitution in the amount of \$11,295.

The D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) investigation revealed that from March 6, 2010, through October 2, 2010, Ms. Whiting engaged in a scheme to defraud DOES by submitting fraudulent claims to obtain unemployment compensation benefits. On August 4, 2015, Ms. Whiting pled guilty to one count of Making a False Statement to Obtain Unemployment Compensation, a misdemeanor.
