Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on October 18, 2013, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Robert Young, a member of the public, to 8 months of incarceration (suspended) and 3 years of supervised probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services (DOES). In addition, the court ordered Mr. Young to pay restitution in the amount of \$15,510.

Special Agent Michele Carter of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from July 2009 through June 2010, Mr. Young received \$15,510 in unemployment insurance compensation benefits from DOES while employed. On August 13, 2013, Mr. Young pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree, a felony.
