Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on January 3, 2014, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Jeffrey Barton, a member of the public, to 6 months of incarceration (suspended), and 5 years of supervised probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services. In addition, the court ordered Mr. Barton to pay restitution in the amount of \$18,000.

Special Agent Alexander Zion of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General along with the U.S. Department of Labor Office of the Inspector General investigators conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from August 2008 through April 2012, Mr. Barton fraudulently obtained \$18,000 in unemployment insurance benefits while working for the Compass Group, a food service contractor for the D.C. Public Schools. After the investigation, on October 21, 2013, Mr. Barton pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree.
