**Re: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT**

Dear Mayor Bowser:

This letter is to inform you that on July 14, 2015, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Tameka Hollins, a private citizen, to 6 months of incarceration (suspended), 5 days of supervised release (suspended), and 3 years of supervised probation for defrauding the Department of Employment Services (DOES). In addition, the court ordered Ms. Hollins to pay restitution in the amount of \$13,768.

The D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) investigation revealed that from July 2, 2011, through July 6, 2013, Ms. Hollins engaged in a scheme to defraud DOES by submitting fraudulent claims to obtain unemployment compensation benefits. On May 8, 2015, Ms. Hollins pled guilty to one count of felony fraud in the second degree.
