Subject: Syreeta Price Ordered to Pay \$22,000 in Restitution for Committing Felony Fraud Against the District of Columbia | 22-00565

Dear Mayor Bowser:

On October 27, 2021, Syreeta Price defrauded the District of Columbia Government by submitting a fraudulent application for STAY DC funds to the Department of Human Services. On February 4, 2025, Ms. Price pled guilty to fraud in the first degree, violating D.C. Code § 22-3221.

On April 8, 2025, the Superior Court for the District of Columbia sentenced Ms. Price to one month of imprisonment (suspended), one year of supervised release (suspended), and five years of unsupervised probation. Additionally, the Court ordered Ms. Price to pay \$100 under the Victims of Violent Crime Compensation Act of 1996 and \$22,000 in restitution.
