Subject: **Jariatu Jalloh Sentenced and Ordered to Repay \$228,991**  
**OIG No. 2026-SAR-02**

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Between approximately August 2021 and July 2023, Ms. Jariatu Jalloh, 40, of Maryland, defrauded the District of Columbia Government by submitting fraudulent encounter notes for community support services she did not provide and overbilling for services to District Medicaid beneficiaries she did not provide. On December 10, 2025, Ms. Jalloh pleaded guilty to two charges of felony fraud in the first degree, violating DC Code §§ 22-3221(a) and 3222(a)(1), and two charges of theft in the first degree, violating DC Code §§ 22-3211, and 3212(a).

On March 13, 2026, the Superior Court for the District of Columbia sentenced Ms. Jalloh to thirty-six months of imprisonment (suspended), three years of supervised release (suspended), and ten years of supervised probation. Additionally, the Court ordered her to actively seek and maintain verifiable employment; participate in a Cognitive Restructuring Program; pay \$400 under the Victims of Violent Crime Compensation Act of 1996; and pay \$228,991 in restitution to the DC Department of Health Care Finance (DC Medicaid) at a rate of \$500 per month. Our office will request the US Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Inspector General, to mandatorily exclude Ms. Jalloh from participating in all federally-funded health care programs for five years.
