Re: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT

Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on April 23, 2014, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Robert Wilkerson, a member of the public, to 90 days of incarceration (suspended), 1 year of supervised release (suspended), and 5 years of supervised probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services. In addition, the court ordered Mr. Wilkerson to pay restitution in the amount of \$17,959.

Special Agent Michele Carter of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from January 2010 through July 2011, Mr. Wilkerson fraudulently obtained \$17,959 in unemployment insurance benefits while working for the Renaissance Hotel. After the investigation, on April 23, 2014, Mr. Wilkerson pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree.
