Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on February 7, 2014, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Cherylene Smith, a member of the public, to 6 months of incarceration (suspended), 3 years of supervised release (suspended), and 5 years of supervised probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services. In addition, the court ordered Ms. Smith to pay restitution in the amount of \$17,644.

Special Agent Emily Hosenbackez of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG), along with agents from the U.S. Department of Labor OIG, conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from October 20, 2009, through September 27, 2010, Ms. Smith fraudulently obtained \$17,644 in unemployment insurance compensation benefits, to which she was not entitled, while working for Pillsbury Winthrop Shaw Pittman, LLC. After the investigation, on December 4, 2013, Ms. Smith pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree.
