Team News - PSG

The Parisians will be without suspended midfielder João Neves, sent off in the Club World Cup final, and goalkeeper Gianluigi Donnarumma, omitted from the squad. New signing Lucas Chevalier is set to start between the posts, while Warren Zaire-Emery could replace Neves in midfield. The rest of Luis Enrique's side is expected to feature the club's trademark attacking firepower.

Team News – Tottenham

Spurs face significant absences, with James Maddison sidelined for much of the season after an ACL injury, Dejan Kulusevski and Radu Drăgușin out, and Yves Bissouma dropped for disciplinary reasons. On the positive side, striker Dominic Solanke is fit, and full-back Destiny Udogie is pushing for a return. New recruit João Palhinha could be handed a key role in midfield.

The Stakes & the Odds

Fresh from lifting the Champions League, PSG enter as clear favourites with bookmakers pricing them at around 2/5. Tottenham, under new boss Thomas Frank, arrive as underdogs but will look to frustrate their opponents and strike on the

counter. Pundits expect goals at both ends, with PSG's depth and attacking options potentially proving decisive.
